TOP TIP
Don't create
detailed drawings,
this is only the
initial stage, get
every idea out
on paper!

STEP ONE

Grab a piece of A4/A5 paper, a pen and a timer.

STEP TWO

Fold paper into 8 pieces (fold it in half, repeat that twice more and open it up)


STEP THREE

Set the timer to 8 minutes and get drawing!

STEP FOUR

Ideally you want to have a drawing a minute but don't let that restrict you, try not to keep your eyes on the timer.
